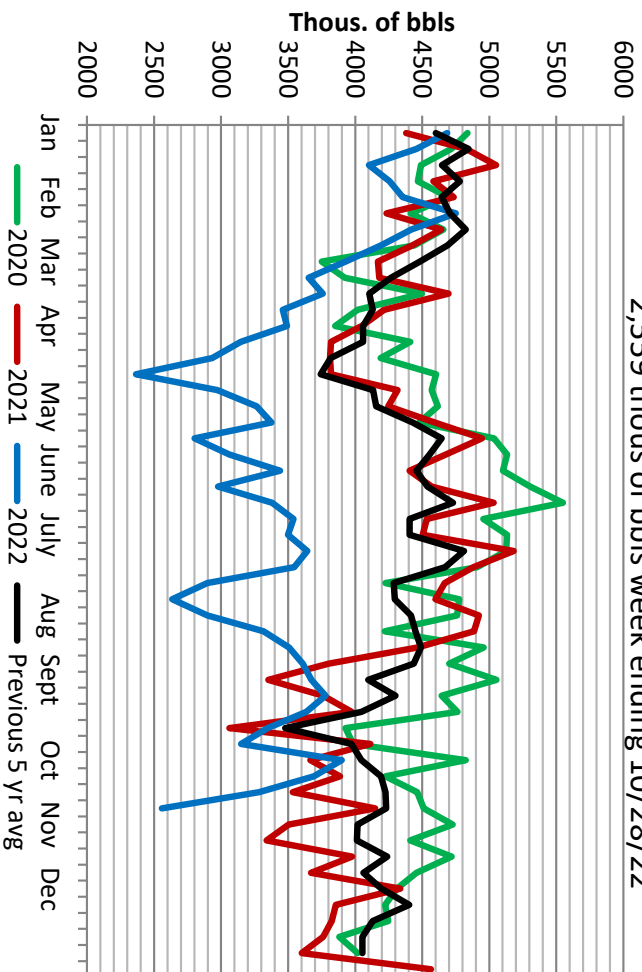

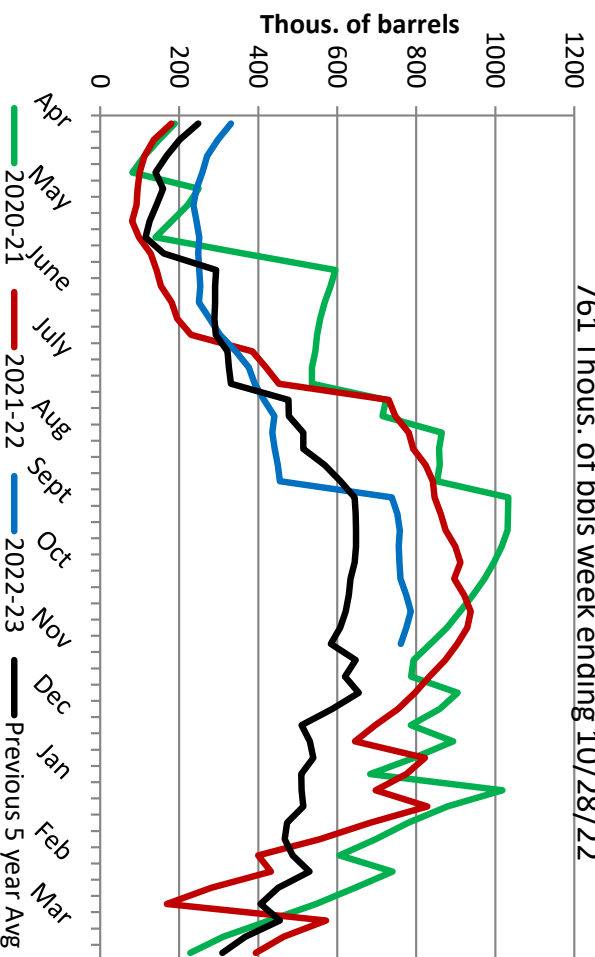
### New England Total Gasoline Stocks

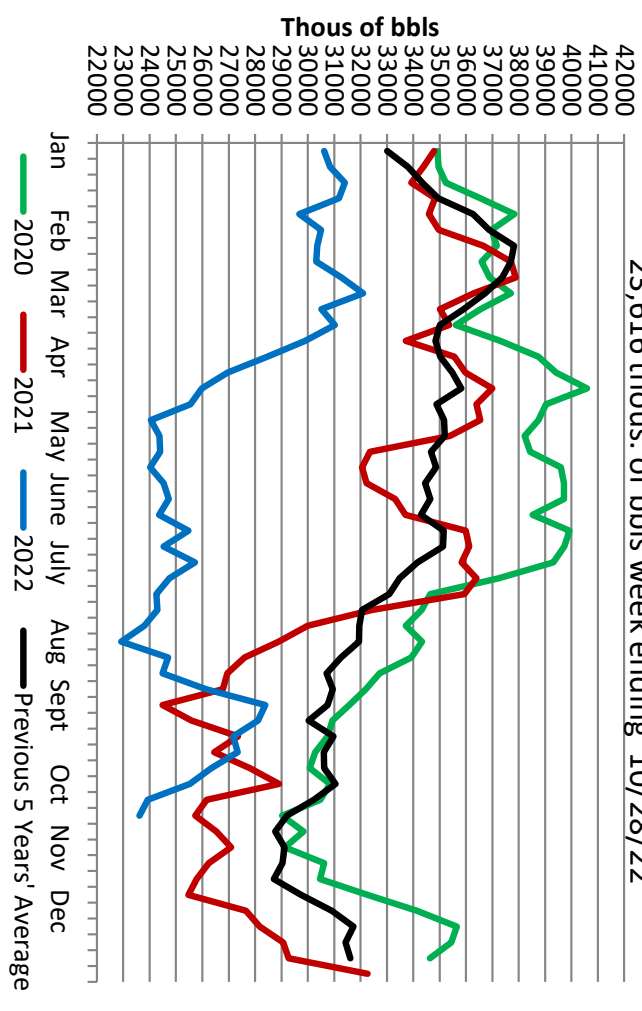
### New England Propane Stocks

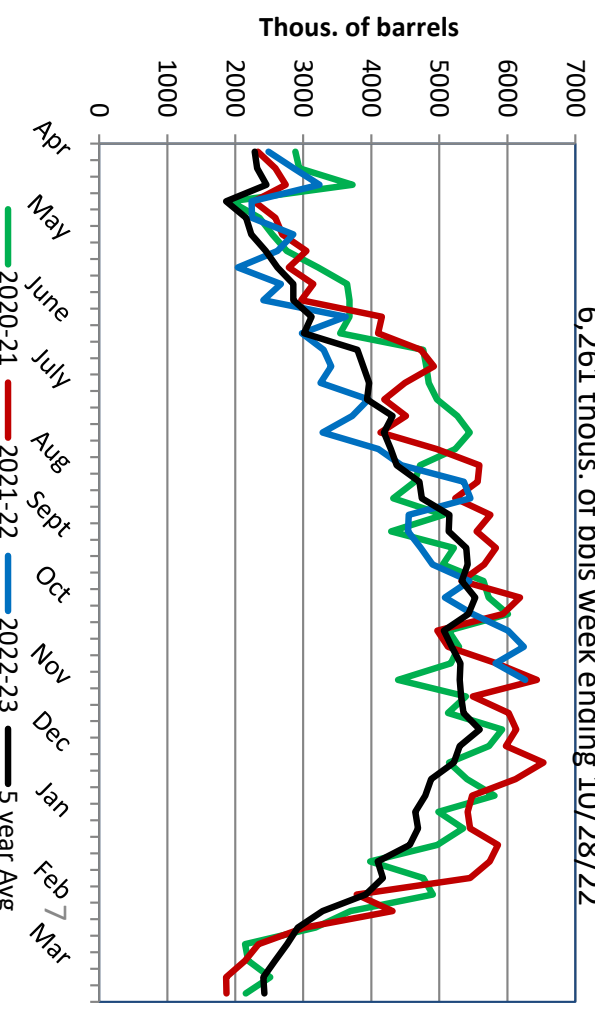
### Mid-Atlantic Gasoline Stocks

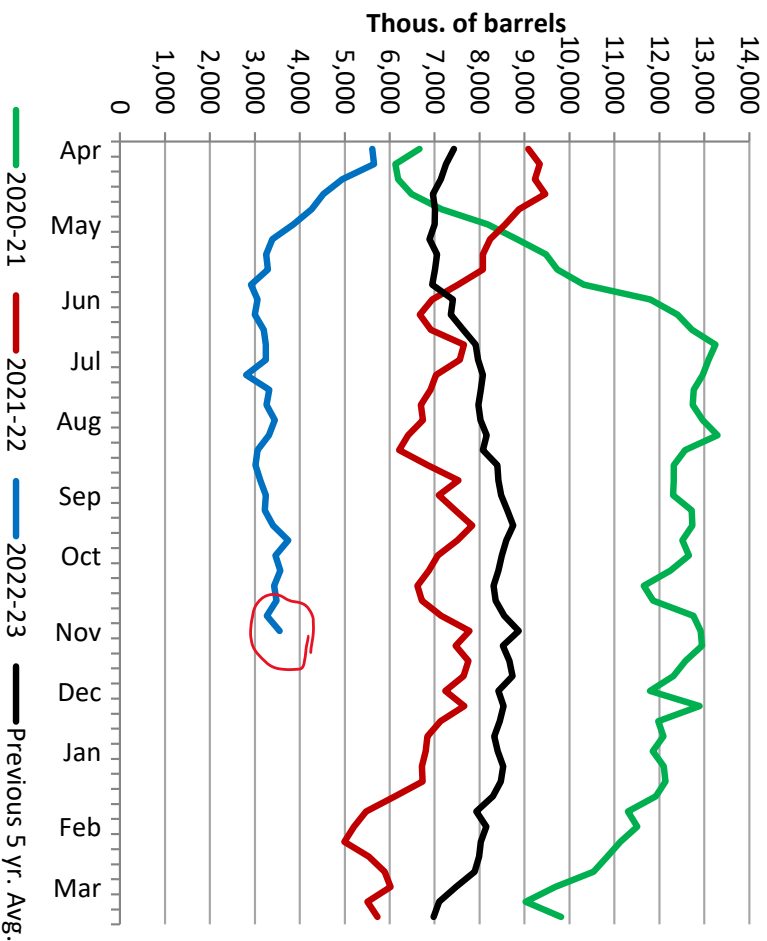

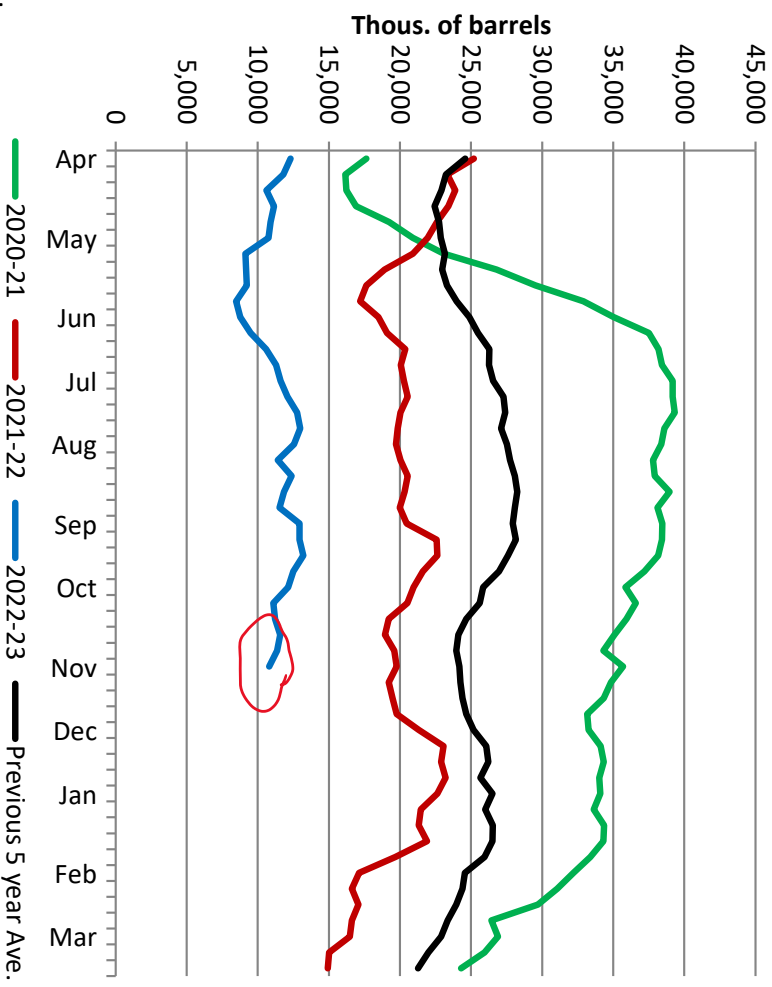


## Distillate Stocks (Heating Oil and Diesel Fuel)

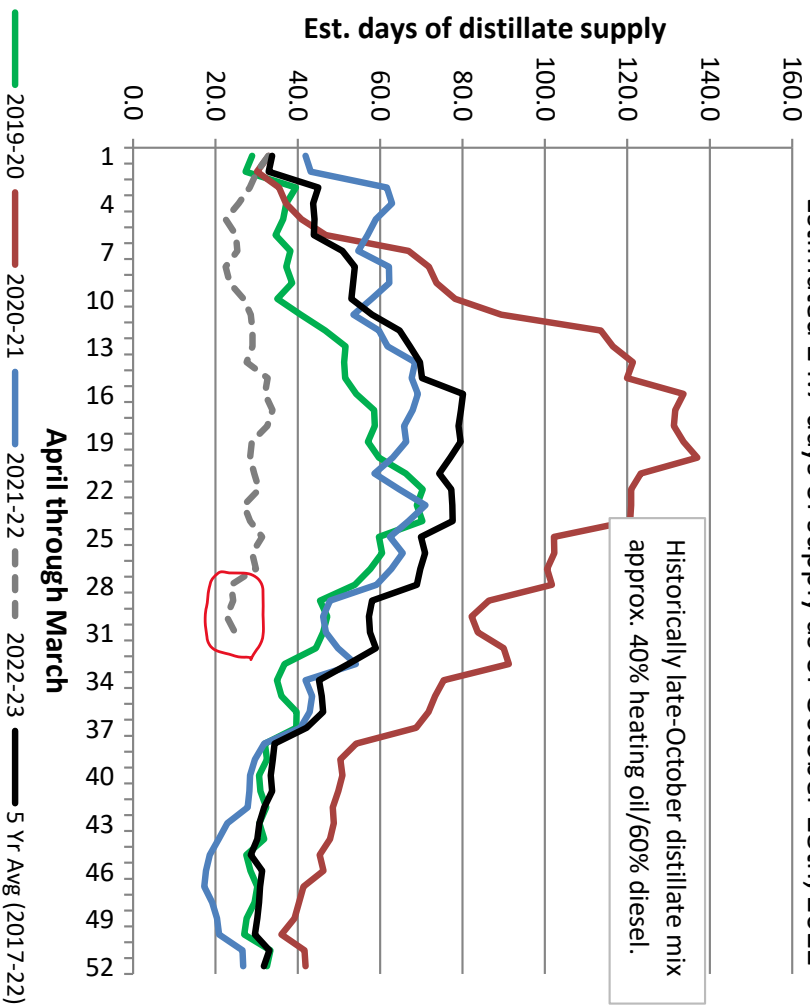

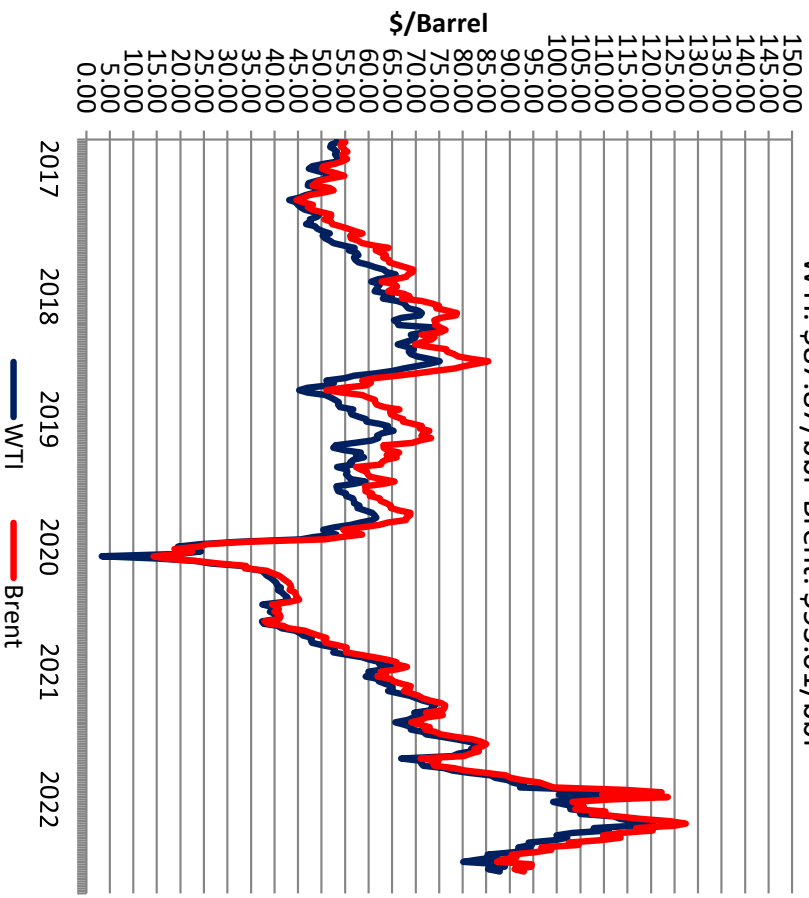
## New England Distillate Days of Supply (Diesel and Home Heating Oil)

## Crude Oil, Weekly Avg. Spot Price

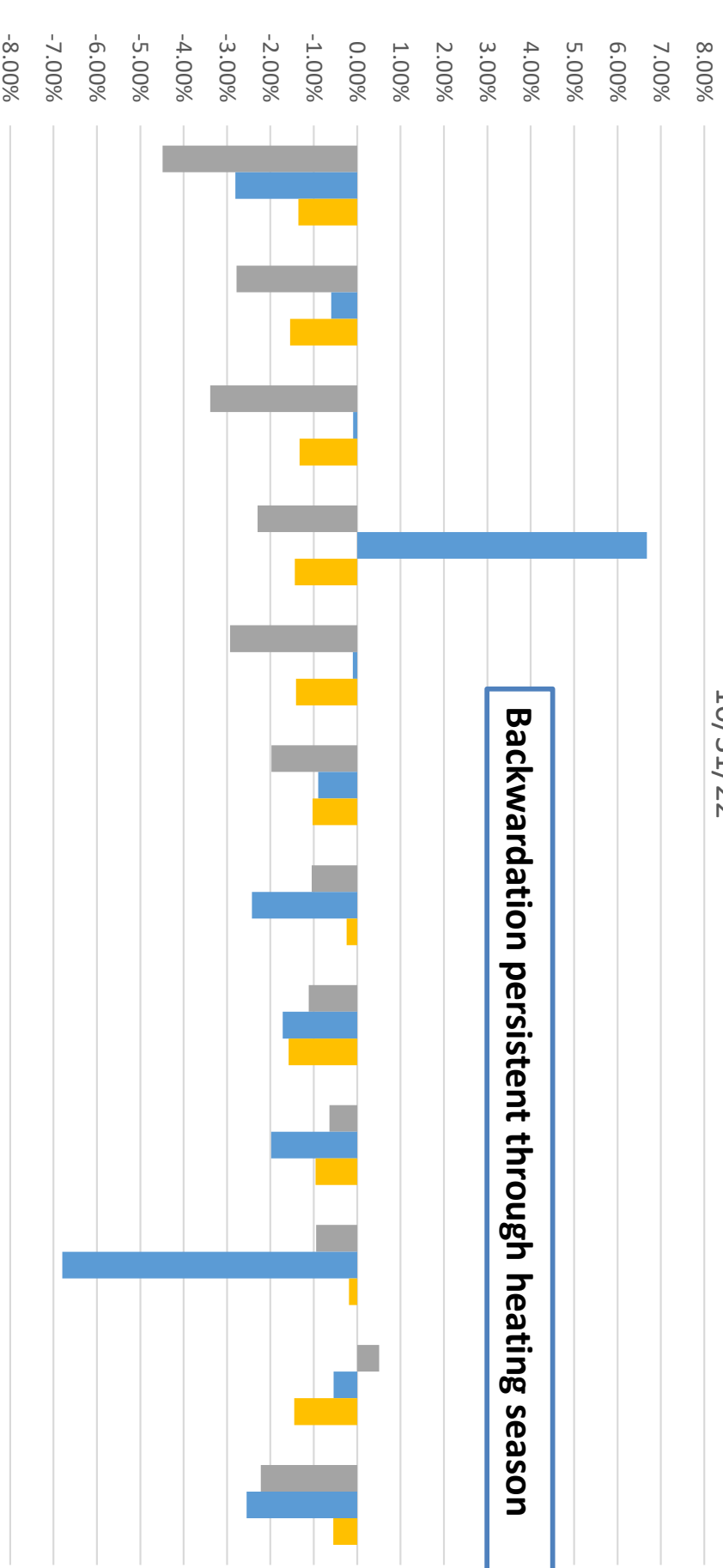

# Heating Oil, RBOB and WTI Backwardation

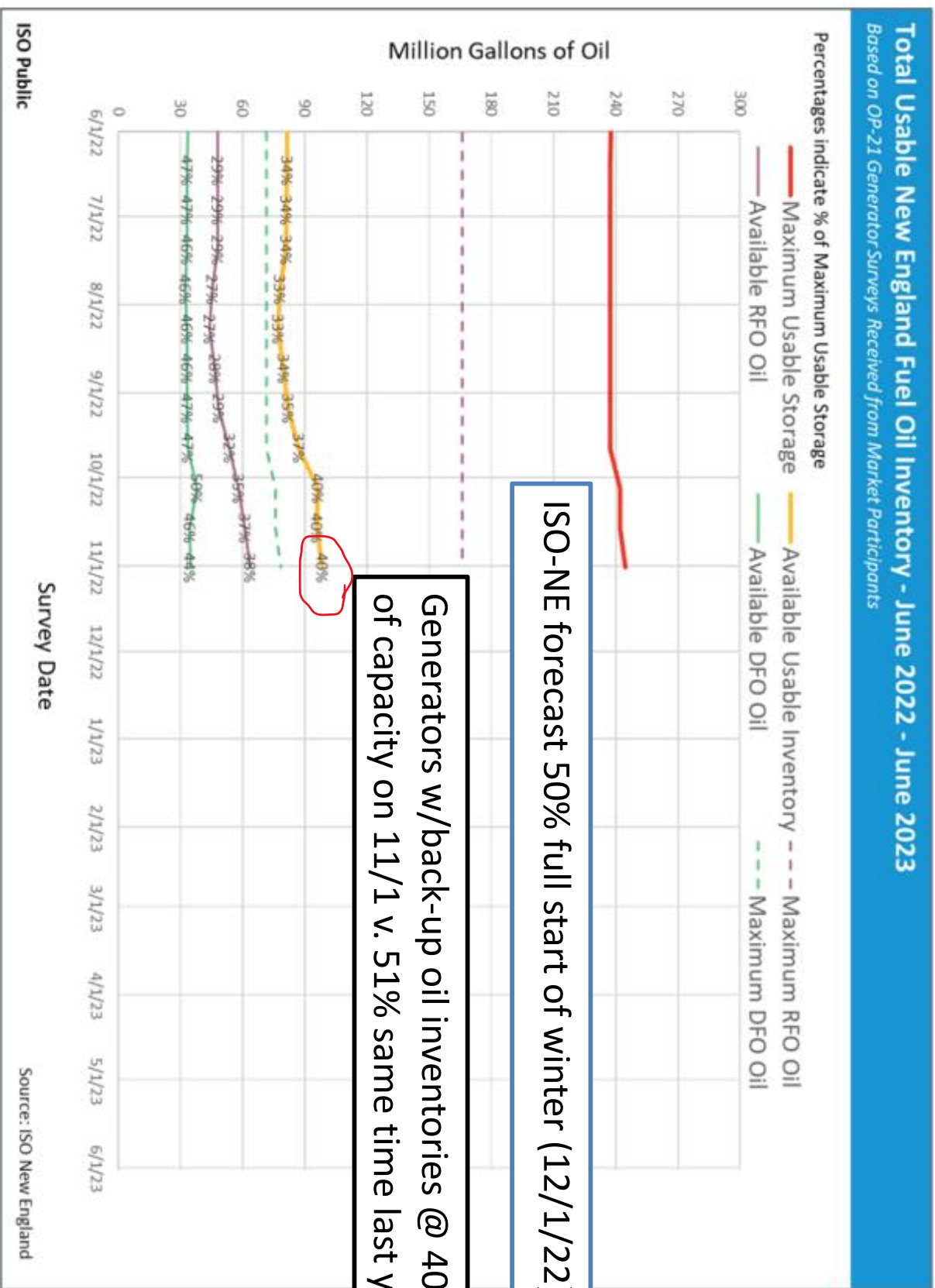
